Summary

The primary function is to provide excellent service to our event guest by supervising and supporting non-profit groups running the concession stands.

Duties and Responsibilities

Verifies the concession stands are stocked and operationally ready for business prior to events.

Verifies concession stand inventory counts on products prior to and after events.

Works with stand groups prior to and throughout events by transferring in/out product, supervise the production of food items that are ready for sale and verifying inventory counts as event progresses. Enforce and ensure all stand workers practice ServSafe food handling/safety procedures.

Supervisory Responsibilities

Be able to effectively work with volunteer groups and organizations to provide the best possible guest experience at concession stands.

Education and Experience

High School diploma or general education degree (GED); or 3-6 months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.

Language, Mathematical, Reasoning Skills

Ability to read and interpret documents such as food safety rules. Ability to add, subtract, multiply and divide. Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form. Ability to communicate and execute instructions via radio.

While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to move around the facility; to stand for long hours during events; talk and hear.
