Summary

Polar Patrol is a seasonal part-time hourly position primarily responsible for the safety and well-being of our ice skating patrons. Work pace is moderate to very busy, dependent upon task. Hours will be after hockey games, on the weekend, and some weekday evenings.

Responsibilities:

- Enforce rules and provide supervision of the arena's public skating sessions
- Constant surveillance of the ice rink and patrons during hours of public skating while never leaving the ice unattended
- Must have the ability to perform basic First Aid
- Aid all skaters that fall and make sure they are not hurt; if any injury occurs notify the facility manager immediately
- Discipline skaters that skate too fast or in a dangerous manner
- Recognize unsafe ice conditions and cone off area when necessary while also contacting the facility manager immediately
- Perform routine skating session maintenance as assigned and as necessary
- Work as a team with fellow venue staff
- Be respectful and friendly at all times. Remember your impressions are important

Qualifications:

- Must be of the age of 18
- Must be able to perform all essential position functions under the working conditions as described
- Proficient communication skills; must be willing to interact with all patrons during public open skate sessions
- Must be self-motivated as well as a hard worker

Supervisory Responsibilities:

This position has no supervisory responsibilities.

Working Conditions:

- Hours will be after hockey games, on the weekends and some weekdays
- This position will be in the ice arena, which at times can be very cold

Physical Demands:

- Patrol must have the ability to skate under control and perform basic skating skills.
- While performing duties of the job, the employee is required to skate, teach/assist, talk and listen to the on goings of public open skate
